We hope everyone had a fantastic Christmas break and we wish you a very Happy New Year.

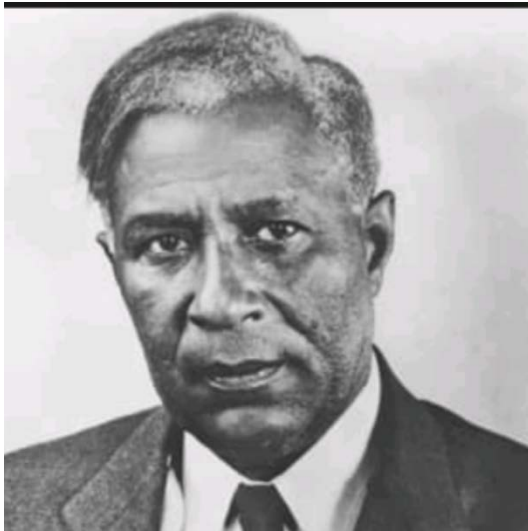

Our Five Senses

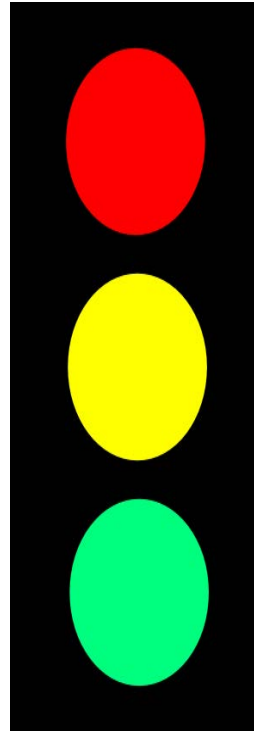
